School District Gymnasium Project on Track

The much-anticipated gymnasium project is currently in the design phase, and progress is well on track. Representatives from InGensa and GLT Architects are continuing meetings with district and school leaders to design and discuss construction of both the gymnasium and support spaces. The meetings cover a wide range of topics including exterior finishes, location and size of designated spaces, interior finishes, gymnasium layout, flooring, along with specific details about the support spaces including the concession stand, locker rooms, training room, wrestling room, and main entrance near the gymnasium.

Once the plan is approved by the board, the district will go out for bids at the end of February. Bids will be awarded at the end of March and construction on the project will begin this summer.

The district will continue to update the community on significant events during the design and construction of the gymnasium.

ACTION NEEDED: Contact Legislators to Ask for Bonding Bill Support

When a natural disaster struck our community last April and Browerville High School lost its muchused classroom, athletic, performance, and community gathering space; the school district and community leaders reached out to the state for emergency financial assistance. Unfortunately, it was too late to be included in the 2023 bonding bill.
