Reports

Mr. Sutlief reported on the following: Homecoming 2017 has come and gone. King Dalton Butler and Queen Olivia Irsfeld. The dance went well with no reported incidents. Some kids left (the weather being nice contributed to that) before the dance ended. NHS sponsored a blood drive for the Red Cross on September 20. A total of 42 units were collected during the drive.
